- 4. Each university, educational institute, college or school must have one central sacred place known as Hall of Fame where photographs of imminent old alumni who have contributed significantly to the society, be displayed as our mark of respect and pride for them. Only such a practice will strengthen Indian value system.

I am ready to render my services at your disposal so that few of your dreams could be given practical shape.

May Almighty bestow his choicest blessings upon you so that your endeavors and efforts to improve HRD activities always touch new heights.
